SPECTATOR TRAVEL

- 1. Use of the club car-park on matchdays will be limited to permit holders
- 2. No parking will be made available to supporters of the away club other than those with a disability
- 3. An Electric charging point in the car-park can be booked in advance. (Parking Permit holders only on matchdays)
- 4. We are a hub for Forest e-bikes
- 5. We will encourage spectators to use public transport, this will be through occasional and varied messaging on our website, on socials media and in our matchday programme.

SPECTATOR TRAVEL PLAN

By Train

The VBS Community Stadium has good public transport links. It is adjacent to West Sutton train station (150m).

By Bus

Buses run along Gander Green Lane and stop almost outside the ground (Route 413, Sutton Station to Morden Underground Station).

To the east of the ground, Sutton Bus Garage is a 2 minute walk away in Bushey Road. Local routes include numbers 80, 151, 164, 213, 280, 407, 413, 470, 613, N44, S1, S2, S3, S4

By Bicycle

The club car-park has a covered Sheffield-style bike rack available for spectator use

By E-Bike

The Club is a hub for Forest E-Bikes. Anyone hiring a Forest E-Bike can leave it at the club.

On Foot

For many local spectators, walking to the stadium may be the most convenient option

By Car

There is no general parking available at the club. If travel by car is essential, we recommend:-

- Car-sharing; minimise the number of vehicles needed
- Use the Gibson Road municipal car park (short walk)

By Supporters' Coach

We recommend that away supporters take advantage of any official club coach travel. After passengers disembark, coaches are asked to park in the Kimpton Road Industrial Estate during games.
