to the club's early years in athletics and rugby before football as we know it began in 1886 with the birth of the club that still does the town proud.

HOW TO GET HERE

BY CAR

From Birmingham, Wolverhampton and North (M5) – Exit M5 at junction (signposted A456) and follow towards Kidderminster (approximately 12 miles). At the roundabout on Kidderminster Ring Road, take the first exit (signposted A451 Stourport). At the next roundabout, take the first exit (signposted A448 Bromsgrove), then take the first turning on right (Hoo Road). Aggborough is approximately half a mile along on the left hand side.

From Worcester and South (M5) – Exit M5 at junction 6 (signposted A449) and follow towards Kidderminster (approximately 15 miles). At the first roundabout, take the third exit (signposted A449, Kidderminster & Wolverhampton), then take the first turning on left before railway bridge. Go down Hoo Road, over the railway bridge, and Aggborough Stadium is on the right hand side.

From South-East (M40 & M42) – Leave M5 at junction 4 (signposted A491 Stourbridge). After approximately 5 miles, turn left onto the A456 and follow towards Kidderminster. At the roundabout on Kidderminster Ring Road, take the first exit (signposted A451 Stourport). At next roundabout, take the first exit (signposted A448 Bromsgrove), then take the first turning on right (Hoo Road). Aggborough Stadium is approximately half a mile along on the left hand side.

BY RAIL

Kidderminster Station (0.5 miles). Walk down Comberton Hill towards the town centre and take the left turning just before Motorway Tyres near the bottom of the hill. Walk up Hoo Road for approximately half a mile to Aggborough Stadium.

PARKING

Supporter parking at Aggborough is extremely limited; restricted to the North Stand Council Car Park, cars can park for £7.50 on a first come, first served basis. The ground is within a residential area, so when parking, please be respectful of local residents at all times.

Please note the requirement to purchase match tickets before entering, as no tickets can be purchased at the turnstiles, with Aggborough also being a cashless venue.

Advance matchday tickets can be purchased on a match-by-match basis, with supporters strongly encouraged to purchase in advance, which can be done up until 15 minutes after kick-off. So, even if you make the late decision to come along, you can still get your ticket via a mobile device on the way, or even once you arrive.

Please note, though, if you decide to purchase in person at the Ticket Office, prices rise by £5, but this is for home fans only - no away supporters can purchase tickets from the Ticket Office.

Any supporters requiring assistance with purchasing online, or have no access to the internet can contact the Club on 01562 823931 before the day of the match.

DISABLED SUPPORTERS, ARMED FORCES & BLUE LIGHT CARD HOLDERS

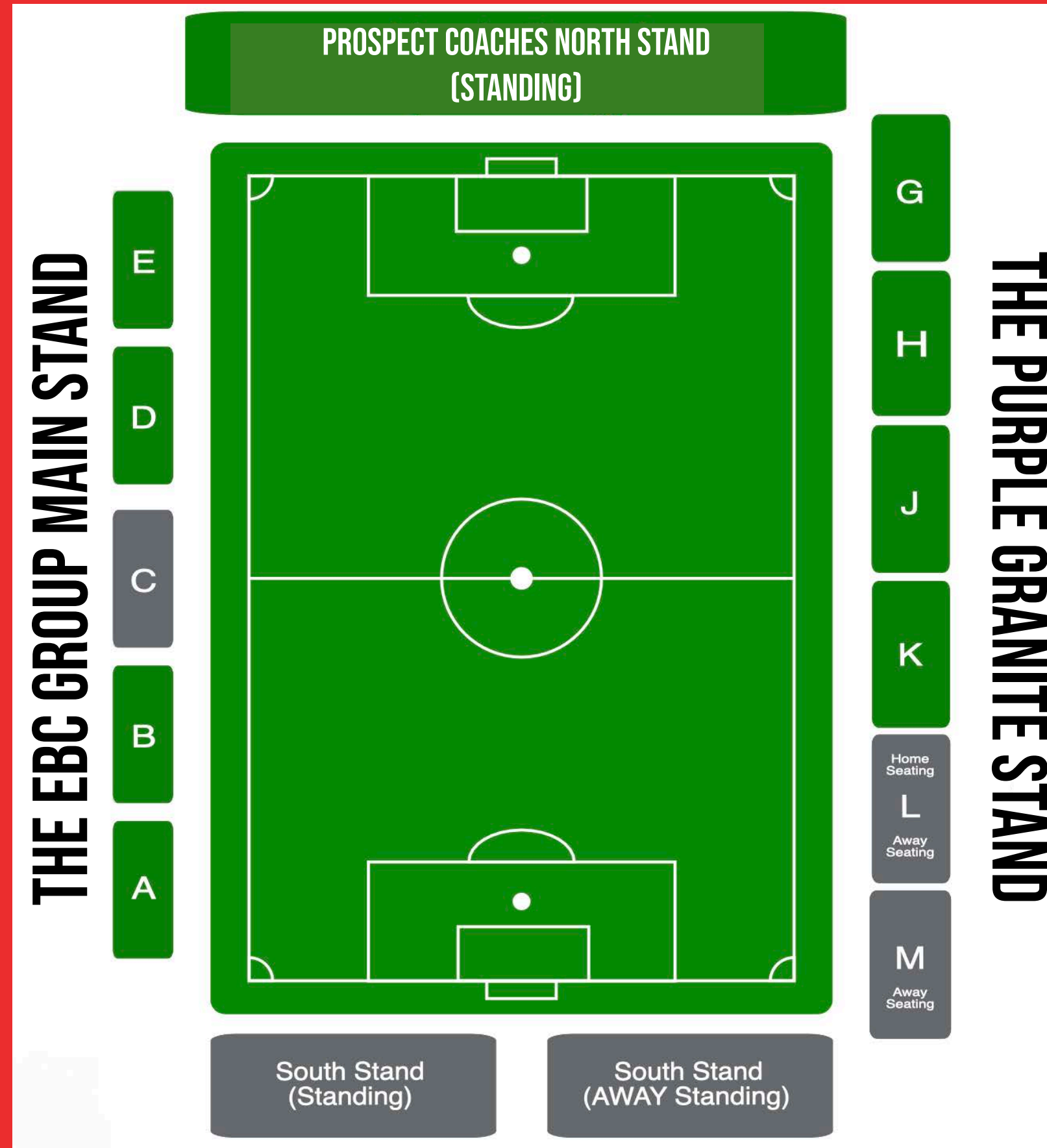
As in previous seasons, disabled supporters can purchase tickets at their respective full price, whilst their nominated carer ticket is free.

Seating for disabled supporters and their carers is located at the front of the EBC Group Main Stand (North Section), as well as the front row of the Purple Granite Stand, and can be purchased by contacting the Club by calling 01562 823931, or

emailing info@harriers.co.uk. Tickets are available on a first come, first served basis.

The same procedure applies to those wishing to gain concession priced tickets as a member of the Armed Forces, or as a Blue Light Card holder, though these tickets are sold in line with all other general ticket types, whilst disabled/carers tickets have a separate allocation.

STADIUM PLAN



AWAY SUPPORTERS

You must purchase tickets before arriving at the Stadium, as away fans are unable to purchase tickets at the venue. Tickets can be purchased online 24/7 via our online ticketing website, and subject to availability, will remain available to buy online up until 15 minutes after kick-off.

Away supporters are also reminded that Aggborough is a cashless venue, so please plan accordingly.

For the vast majority of matches at Aggborough, away fans will be seated in the East Stand, an all-seated stand that runs the length of the pitch, or the South Stand terrace which is behind the goal to the left of the East Stand as you sit.

Where a large travelling contingent is expected, away

supporters will also then be housed in the South Stand terrace, which is behind the goal to the right-hand side of the tunnel as you enter the pitch.

There are refreshment facilities within easy reach for away fans at Aggborough, wherever they're housed.

Programmes at Aggborough are priced at £3.50 and are packed with details covering both teams, plus plenty of other great content. Available at every home game, programmes can be purchased from the ground on the day of the game, or online.

* Those purchasing an Under 16s or Student/Young Adult (16-21) ticket may require proof of ID upon entry to the ground for tickets purchased at this price.

> The minimum age for any child to enter the ground unaccompanied is 13. Any child under the age of 13 MUST be accompanied by a paying adult.

> Proof of entitlement is required for those claiming concessionary rate for Armed Forces & Blue Light Card holders, who can book tickets at the Over 65 rate. For further details please refer to page 3 of this brochure.
